Responsibilities

- Support the Lead Cook to facilitate and implement all facets of meal delivery for a range of 15 to 40 people (including students and staff) each week or as needed. Includes:
 - Food prep, cooking and serving meals
 - Clean-up of meals including keeping food preserved for future meals
 - Help supervise campers in the kitchen
 - Assisting Lead Cook in food shopping if/when needed
 - Maintenance of kitchen facilities with a high standard of organization and cleanliness
 - Transferring food to various locations in camp as needed
 - Report to the Lead Cook, Program Director and School Directors

- Experience with food service for large groups. Camp experience preferred.

- Creative and fun loving
