Responsibilities

- Attend and positively contribute towards high quality planning and debrief sessions
- Report to the Lead Instructors, Program Director and School Directors

- Must have a sincere desire to work with deep nature connection mentoring, working with youth ages 6-18 in an outdoor setting
- Must be 18 years or older and have a valid driver's license
- Must agree to a background check

- Passionate and curious student of the earth; versatile and can adapt to changes
- Physically fit and in shape
- Ability to safely use and maintain a variety of different tools and gear and ensure that for others
- Ability to successfully take care of personal needs and tend your own inner fire and can demonstrate a positive countenance, mood and spirit upon arrival, during and departure of programs.
- Commitment to peace, positive communication, inclusiveness, appreciation, integrity, unity and love.
- Commitment to joyful, hard work
- Keep a clean and orderly environment

Mentoring

- Safety and hazard awareness competency
- Working joyfully in a collaborative team environment
- Self-motivated, accountable
- Basic communication skills with people including parents, children and families
- Creative and fun loving
- Positive and competent outlook in both calm and challenging situations
- Positively receive feedback for positive growth as part of the mentoring experience
- Ability to take directives when needed

Preference will be given to applicants who have:

- Experience in the diverse species and skills of the natural world including hazards, mammals, plants, ecological indicators, trees & birds, as well as naturalist skills, tracking, wild edible & medicinal plants, aidless navigation, ecology, permaculture, wilderness survival and bird language
- Experience with deep nature connection mentoring, working with youth ages 6-18 in an outdoor setting
- Experience as a storyteller, song leader, musician and/or in the arts
- Strong organizational skills
- Ability to set and communicate boundaries for youth in a positive way
- Ability to passionately engage and motivate children in developmentally appropriate activities
- Graduated the Twin Eagles Wilderness Immersion Program (or equivalent), and/or Kamana Naturalist Training Program.
- Certification in First Aid and CPR training.
