Twin Eagles Wilderness School is looking to hire an adult **Lead Cook** for Twin Eagles Overnight Summer Camps 2020. We have a strong reputation as a powerful center for passion-based deep nature connection in the Inland Northwest with positive mentoring relationships with the families and individuals we work with.

Responsibilities

- Facilitate and implement all facets of meal delivery for a range of 25 to 45 people (including students and staff) each week. Includes:
 - Planning a menu with opportunities for creativity while meeting dietary needs of participants and staff
 - Planning a shopping list, and purchasing food items.
 - Planning recipes
 - Coordination with program staff on timing and delivery of meals
 - Outdoor kitchen setup, organization, maintenance, break down and pack up
 - Food prep, cooking and presenting and serving meals
 - Directing and supervising assistant cook when present
 - Coordination and supervision of kitchen volunteers (including participant volunteers)
 - Maintenance of kitchen facilities with a high standard of organization and cleanliness
 - Monitoring of food supplies and efficient use of ingredients on hand
 - Restocking of food supplies as needed (store, bulk, farmers market)
 - Responsible handling of money and receipts when relevant, staying within budget
 - Report to the Program Director and School Directors

Qualifications

- Experience with food service for large groups. Camp experience preferred.
- Ability to successfully take care of personal needs and tend your own inner fire and can demonstrate a positive countenance, mood and spirit before, during and after programs.
- We expect that you will initiate self-care by taking breaks when you need to, and balancing this with the responsibilities of the role.
- Safety and hazard awareness competency
- Responsible, peaceful, loving, enthusiastic and team oriented
- Creative and fun loving
- Versatile and can adapt to changes
- High level of skill with and commitment to positive communication
- Self-motivated, accountable and have strong organizational skills
- Positive and competent outlook in both calm and challenging situations
- Ability to include and appreciate others
- Must enjoy being around youth and adults
- Ability to lift 50 pounds
- Ability to keep camp clean and orderly
- Commitment to joyful, hard work
- Positively receive feedback for positive growth as part of the experience
- Ability to take directives when needed
- Share a passion for deep nature connection, wilderness skills, and nature based mentoring
- Clean driving record and access to personal vehicle
- Must be 18 years or older, have a valid driver's license, and agree to a background check

- Food Purchasing Day OR Break Day - Saturday July 25
- Food Purchasing Day - Sunday July 26
- Overnight Camp for Teens (13 & up) - Monday July 27 - Sunday August 2
- Camp Clean up, breakdown and pack up Day on Monday, August 3

Overnight Camps location 30 minutes north of Priest River, ID.
